2018 Chili & Cupcake Cook-Off and Benefit Rules and Guidelines

General

- Each contestant must fill out entry form and send in the \$10 entry fee (fee covers one admission ticket) by May 15, 2018.
- Please bring a list of all ingredients printed and ready to view (for people with allergies)
- Chili and cupcake contestants will be judged at 4:00. Awards will be presented at 5:00 pm.
- Contestants are responsible for cleaning their area.
- At the event, you will need to write the name and type of chili/cupcake on a small index card.
- Judges decisions are final. Failure to comply with officials in any matter may be cause for disqualification.

Chili Cooks

Please Bring:

- Your chili already warm and ready to serve in a crock pot. A Nesco is fine but it sucks up a lot of electricity!
- One extension cord for your crock pot
- Serving Ladle (a small one works best since the cups hold about 2 Tbs. of chili)
- Hot pads to protect you and the tables
- All applicants are required to make one full pot (at least 4 quarts) of chili.
- Table chairs, bowls, spoons, and napkins will be provided.
- All varieties of chili are eligible: meat, bean, chicken, turkey, vegetarian, etc. (no venison or wild game)
- All edible chili peppers legal in the U.S.A are eligible.
- Chili cooks may be asked to taste their own chili before submitting for judging.
- You may provide chili additives such as cheese but judges will taste your chili straight up with no toppings so it needs to stand on its own

Cupcake Bakers

Please Bring:

- 2 dozen cupcakes in cupcake liners to be judged on appearance, taste, texture.
- Napkins will be provided.

P.S. Food should look good, smell good, and taste good! Interesting presentation is a plus so feel free to bring props.
